

Grant-Fit Concept Brief

Proposal-ready R&D; framing for a resilient agent runtime and transition path.

Flagship concept	Resilient Agent Runtime for Low-Resource Government Systems: bounded actions, recovery controls, measurable research, and dual-use commercialization.
Program fit	NSF AI SBIR/STTR, DARPA/IPTO, DHS S&T; SBIR, and DoW SBIR/STTR when a topic aligns. DoW RISE is a transition path, not a standard grant.
Planning bands	Phase I feasibility: \$250K-\$350K. Phase II prototype / validation: \$750K-\$1.8M. Transition / acquisition planning: \$1.5M-\$3M+; not a standard grant ceiling.
Submission boundary	Eligibility, topic alignment, allowable costs, and award size depend on the solicitation. Tailor to the agency topic; do not submit a generic platform proposal.
